



Pathological Society Winter School 2010 Monday 25 January to Friday 29 January Kensington Close Hotel, London

The Winter School is a week-long course that forms part of a continuing three-year cycle that aims to provide Histopathologists, both in training and in consultant practice, with a series of high quality presentations covering key aspects of Surgical Pathology, Cytopathology and Autopsy Pathology. Each participant will receive a slide box in advance of the course containing slides that will be discussed by the speakers. In addition a dedicated website will allow access to virtual slides that will also feature in the presentations. A Virtual Classroom will be available throughout the week to allow direct access to the virtual slides. The website will continue to provide participants with on-line access to the slides after the course has finished.

- Fraser Charlton – Aspects of dermatopathology
- Ian Roberts, Oxford – Biopsy diagnosis of system disease in renal biopsies
- James Underwood, Sheffield – 'Tis not unlikely fancy will betray you into error
- Jorge Reis-Filho, London – Advances in breast cancer diagnosis
- Mike Wells, Sheffield – Problems and solutions in gynaecological pathology
- Nigel Kirkham – Diagnosis of the borderline melanocytic skin lesions
- Philip Sloan – Biopsy diagnosis in head and neck pathology
- Sanjiv Manek, Oxford – New concepts in gynaecological pathology

The programme also includes a mock examination, with advice on the approach to success and feedback on performance in the mock.
