



PATHOLOGICAL SOCIETY MEETING BURSARY

A number of bursaries will be made available to cover the **cost of registration fees and costs of up to £500.00** for **Society members** who are post-graduate students (PhD, MD or MSc) or Pathology trainees and wish to **present their research** at **Society meetings**. An **additional amount of up to £125.00** is available for **child care fees**. An applicant whose work is/has been selected for presentation in a plenary session will be favoured.

The terms and conditions of the Pathological Society Meeting Bursary Scheme are as follows:

- 1 Applicants must be **members of the Society**.
- 2 The Society logo must be used on all presentations.
- 3 A one-page report of the value of the meeting must be sent to the Society office within three months of attending the meeting. **Failure to provide a report will preclude future support in this and other schemes run by the Society.**
- 4 An electronic application must be received no later than **31 December** to qualify for a bursary to attend the Path Society winter meeting, London in January of the following year & **31 May** to attend the summer Joint meeting with the BDIAP. - 5 The Society will normally withdraw funding if the grant is not acknowledged and accepted within 6 months of the offer
